Alyssa Lobit (Actress, Writer, Producer, Filmmaker... Storyteller)



Alyssa Lobit recently produced her first feature, which she wrote and starred in, *The Things We Carry*. The screenplay is a 2007 Academy Nicholl Fellowships Quarterfinalist, placing in the top 5% of 5,050 entries of this prestigious competition.

In 2007, Ms. Lobit developed a comedy TV pilot she co-wrote, directed by Brian Austin Green (*90210*). She acted in it alongside Jennifer Blanc (*Dark Angel*) and Dana Daurey (*Providence*).

Ms. Lobit was a founding member of The Factory, whose theater production of *Night Coil* received critical acclaim. She made her debut as a director and producer in the film industry with *One Man's Trash*, which won the Los Angeles Flickering Image Film Fest and was a finalist in the highly competitive IndieProducer Contest. She developed *OMT* from script to screen and also acted in it. The short is currently digitally distributed via UK-based WYSIWYG (wysiwygfilms.com).

As an actress, Ms. Lobit has received critical acclaim for her stage performances, including recognition for a "standout performance" in the World Premiere of *Slow Boat* and an LA Weekly Nomination for her performance in *Night Coil*. Ms. Lobit has also appeared in several short films that have screened and won awards at festivals across the country. Additionally, she has appeared in several commercials, notably the national Nokia campaign in conjunction with *American Idol*.

In addition to her professional work as an actress and filmmaker, Ms. Lobit has worked as a story analyst, providing detailed development notes on screenplays. She is a founding member of the Los Angeles-based filmmakers collective Game On, directing, producing and editing nine shorts during the series. Alyssa graduated cum laude from U.C.L.A. with a B.A. in English.
